**THE DEADLINE FOR REGISTRATION IS 8.11.2022. until 24.00**

Weighing takes place before the start of the appropriate category (visually by choice).

Permissible weight - 200 g.

At the beginning of the category - weight claims are not accepted.

### Participation in the competition:

All athletes must have an identity document or passport. The athlete is responsible for his / her own health insurance and medical condition.

### Participation fee:

25 EUR for participation in Kata & Kumite categories.

20 EUR for participation in Sumo & Fantom categories.

### Regulations:

Photography and video filming will take place at the competition venue, the captured photos may be used by the competition organizers in self-promotional materials without the consent of the people in them.

WKF regulations, which have been approved by the Board of the Latvian Karate Federation, with changes made by the organizer, which have been approved by the Board of the Latvian Karate Federation. Area size 7m x 7m.

The categories are held according to the round system, each subgroup consists of 3-5 athletes, and after the subgroup fights, the best 2 athletes from each group continue the fight for medals according to the Olympic system. Flag system in all categories. Kata 3 judges, kumite 3 judges.

KATA:

- Athletes are allowed to perform only the following kata: Taikioku, Heian 1-5, Pinan 1-5, Ten-no-kata 1-3, Gekisadai 1-2, Saifa., Zenshin-kotai;
- One kata can be completed in all categories.
- Athletes perform kata simultaneously;
- An athlete may participate in one kyu category!

## KUMITE:

- U8 and U10 – fight duration 1 min.
- U12, U14 and U16 - fight duration 1.30 min
- An athlete may participate in one weight category;
- Athletes, their coaches and parents are independently responsible for any injuries obtained as a result of not using the equipment!
- Equipment: The color of the gloves and belt must match the color of the athlete in the respective bout (AKA or AO). The color of the leg guards does not matter.

## SUMO:

- The championship takes place according to the round system; the size of the fighting field is 3x3m
- According to the SUMO rules approved by LKF.

## PHANTOM KUMITE:

- Takes place according to the round system (time 20 sec.).

## Rewarding:

1st place, 2nd place and two 3rd places in all categories are awarded with medals. 1st place winners will also be awarded with cups.

## COVID – 19

Both the organizer and all other clubs (including athletes and their parents, as well as judges and coaches) strictly follow the "Latvian Karate Federation regulations to reduce the risk of Covid-19".

Viewers are allowed to use an interoperable Covid-19 certificate. \*
